Chaffey College's Pathway to Law school program received the Diversity Champion Award at the 2020 Pathway to Law School Summit, which occurred before the pandemic lockdown. The award was presented by Thuy Thi Nguyen, the president of Foothill College and a board member of California LAW, Inc., for Chaffey's "excellence . . . and leadership in introducing students to careers in the law through the California LAW Pathway."
