- 1. Call To Order/New Committee Members:** The meeting was called to order at 1:38p.m. The Chair introduced our guest who is a student from Chaffey's ASCC Government, Maria Isabell Sandoval.
- 2. Review and Approval of February 1, 2017 Expanded Summary Notes:** The summary notes were approved 12/0/1 as presented.
- 3. Discussion Items:**
  - 3.1. Distance Education Updates:** The Chair shared that she and the Administrative Assistant presented the DE Addendum to DE Committee earlier today. At the DE Committee meeting, the Chair asked the committee to email the Curriculum Office their suggestions and corrections before the addendum is sent to Curricunet to replace the old DE Checklist. The Chair also shared that "Distance Education" will no longer be a selection option in Curricunet. All DE will now fall under a course modification (or new course proposal) as all DE addenda should be updated and regularly reviewed at the same time face-to-face courses are being reviewed, modified, and/or updated. Some committee members agreed that this process is a more streamlined approach that will save faculty time while addressing the concerns of ACCJC. The committee approved the technical Curricunet integration of the DE addendum with the course modification process 14/0/0.

The Chair also distributed a list of DE courses in Curricunet. She and the VPI would like the Deans and Discipline Faculty to review the list. If there are any discrepancies and/or concerns, Deans and Faculty are encouraged to

contact the Curriculum Office. The committee would like Faculty to begin updating their DE Addenda once the DE process and addendum is consolidated and finalized in the Fall.

The Director of Admissions and Records, Kathy Lucero, shared a change in the registration dates that may affect Curriculum approvals. Students will now register in May for the fall semester. As a result, the Curriculum calendar will be altered for the next academic year to align with registration changes.
