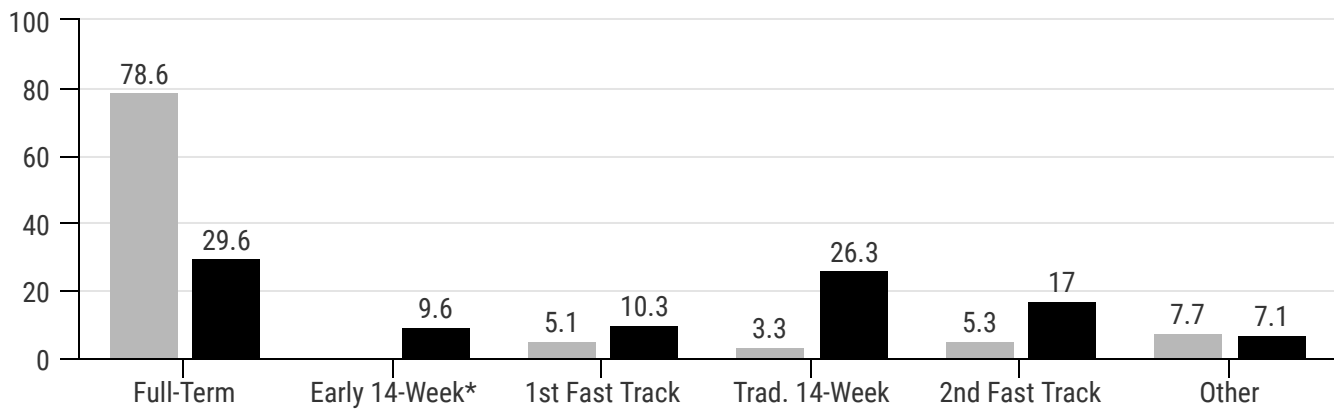


## Student Enrollment Patterns by Session Length

Overview: Now that census dates have passed for almost all census procedure sections, the Office of Institutional Research (OIR) examined student enrollment patterns by session length (full-term, early 14-week, 1st fast track, traditional 14-week, 2nd fast track, and other session lengths).

### Percentage of Sections Offered by Session Length - FA19/FA22 Comparison

In fall 2019 (the last pre-pandemic fall term), 475 sections were offered in a length other than full-term. In fall 2022, 1,481 sections are being offered in a length other than full-term, a 311.8% increase.

### Most Common Student Enrollment Patterns - Fall 2022 Semester
