

AP 5410 Student Government Elections

The Office of Student Life conducts student elections for the Student Government every spring term in April.

Polls are open both day and evening hours. Voting is conducted at the Rancho Cucamonga, Chino, and Fontana campuses.

Any student elected as an officer of the Student Government must meet the requirements in BP 5410 titled Student Government Elections as well as those stated in the Student Government of Chaffey College ratified constitution. Unit and grade point average (GPA) requirements are strictly followed.

To maintain office, the student must complete six units per term and have a cumulative GPA of 2.25.

The governing documents for the Student Government are the Constitution and Bylaws.

Offices are held for one year, unless disqualification occurs. There is a term limit of three years.

The process for disqualification is outlined in the Constitution and Bylaws of the Student Government, which is available in the Office of Student Life.
