

BP 3250 Institutional Planning

The Superintendent/President shall ensure that the District has and implements a broad-based comprehensive, systematic, and integrated system of planning and evaluation that involves appropriate segments of the college community and is supported by institutional effectiveness research.

The planning system shall include plans required by law, including but not limited to:

- Long Range Educational Vision which shall be updated as deemed necessary by the Governing Board
- Facilities Plan
- Equal Employment Opportunity Plan
- Student Equity Plan
- Student Success and Support Plan
- Transfer Center Plan
- Cooperative Work Experience Plan
- Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) Plan
- Integrated Planning Manual

The Superintendent/President shall inform the Governing Board about the status of planning and the various plans and ensure that the Governing Board has an opportunity to assist in developing the general institutional mission and goals for the comprehensive plans.
