

BP 6100 Delegation of Authority – Business and Fiscal Affairs

The Governing Board delegates to the Superintendent/President the authority to supervise the general business procedures of the District to assure the proper administration of property and contracts; the budget, audit, and accounting of funds; the acquisition of supplies, equipment and property; and the protection of assets and persons. All transactions shall comply with applicable laws and regulations, and with the California Community Colleges Budget and Accounting Manual.

No contract shall constitute an enforceable obligation against the District until it has been approved or ratified per applicable statutes, codes, and regulations by the Governing Board. (See BP 6340 titled Bids and Contracts.)

The Superintendent/President or designee shall make appropriate periodic reports to the Governing Board and shall keep the Governing Board fully advised regarding the financial status of the District.
