

BP 6520 Security for District Property

The Superintendent/President shall:

- Establish procedures necessary to manage, control, and protect the assets of the District, including but not limited to ensuring sufficient security to protect property, equipment, and information from theft, loss, or significant damage.
- Provide reasonable security for or to protect property, equipment, information and files from loss or significant damage.
- Regulate the appropriate use of District-owned equipment and facilities and employee-owned property used in the performance of official duties.
