BP 7330 Communicable Disease

The Superintendent/President shall assure that:

- All newly hired academic employees shall have on file a medical certificate indicating freedom from communicable diseases, including, but not limited to, active tuberculosis, disqualifying the applicant from instructing or associating with students. No academic employee shall commence service until such medical certificate has been provided to the District.
- All newly hired employees must show that they have been examined within the past 60 days to determine that they are free from active tuberculosis.
- All employees shall be required to undergo an examination within four years of employment and every four years thereafter to determine if they are free from tuberculosis.
