UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- a. **Virtual Escape Room Event** – The Events Committee will discuss and take possible action on the virtual escape room event for the spring semester and establish rules/guidelines for this event. *Director Christine Cabrera was speaking about how we need to choose a new date and time for the event. Dean Brunelle announced how the team prices went down from \$40 to \$28 per team. Spoke about opening it up on Monday, January 31st, and close it that Friday, Feb 11, 2022 at 12:00 pm. We're also speaking about the rules and the friendly competition between faculty and students, but faculty would NOT be winning any prizes. - b. **Virtual Meet & Greet with the Presidents** – An Events Committee senator will be assigned to pick a new day and time for this event in spring semester 2022. Director Cabrera started, but Dean Brunelle mentioned that we need to reach out to Dr. Shannon and he would be able to give us some dates to get together and talk. Open panel, other ideas.

- d. **Club Rush** - The committee will discuss how to register for Club Rush. The committee will discuss incentives for club rush members who attend the next CCSG meeting. *Director Christine told us to register and show up to this event.*
- e. **Elections** - The committee will discuss how to promote the upcoming CCSG general elections through related events. Other homework announced by Director Christine is to come up with ideas for how to promote the election and to collect ideas.
