- **Motion for Approval** - Senator Boboye moved to approve the 10.17.23 Consent Agenda. Senator Holdiness seconded the motion. The motion was approved. 10.17.23, 19Y/0N/0A.
- Vice President Encarnacion commented on seeing the same people on a variety of hiring committees. Some individuals have been asked to serve on seven committees. President DeRose and Senator Ming replied that RoseAnn requested to be put on this committee and the incidences of committee representation and hiring committee participation are different.

7.1 President

- Academic Senate Chaffey College Student Government (CCSG) Liaison
 - CCSG President and Student Trustee has appointed Ryan Thomas, CCSG Director of Finance, to serve as the CCSG Liaison to the Academic Senate.
 - Beginning with the October 24 meeting, the CCSG Liaison will now appear on future agendas and will have the opportunity to provide a report from CCSG.
 - This will provide opportunities for Academic Senate, Classified Senate, and CCSG to be informed of areas of focus for participatory governance and for potential participatory governance mutual areas of focus.
 - Congratulations to Ryan Thomas, and welcome to the Academic Senate.
- Guest Thomas said thank you and added that CCSG is working to increase the amount of student participation.

7.2 Vice President

- Many groups across campus have expressed a “culture of fear” and fear of retaliation from speaking up against necessary aspects due to the incident that occurred after Michelle Martinez reported to the Academic Senate, and then seemingly was fired from that position immediately after. These individuals and groups are worried about grants that are associated with their work, and the allocation of the grant funds. This is repeated on the classified side as well.
- Senator Chamberlain inquired whether CCFA had been involved. Vice President Encarnacion replied that some may not feel comfortable to reach out to the union for a presentation on retaliation. Senator Jenkins suggested for CCFA to come to the Academic Senate. Senator Johnson expressed the need for faculty to have a safe space for these types of discussions.

- Liaison Schmidt shared that the Classified Senate met with the District regarding the upcoming Holiday Event. This event has been a tradition since the 1990's but had to stop during Covid. Senator Schmidt shared that the event has been held at multiple sites in the past to meet the needs of different campus members' ability to attend. The District stated they want one full event at Rancho Sports Center.
- Liaison Schmidt confirmed that the Classified Senate also discussed a lack of trust on campus. Vice President Encarnacion offered support for the Classified Senate. Senator Chamberlain suggested that the academic Senate provide a statement of support.

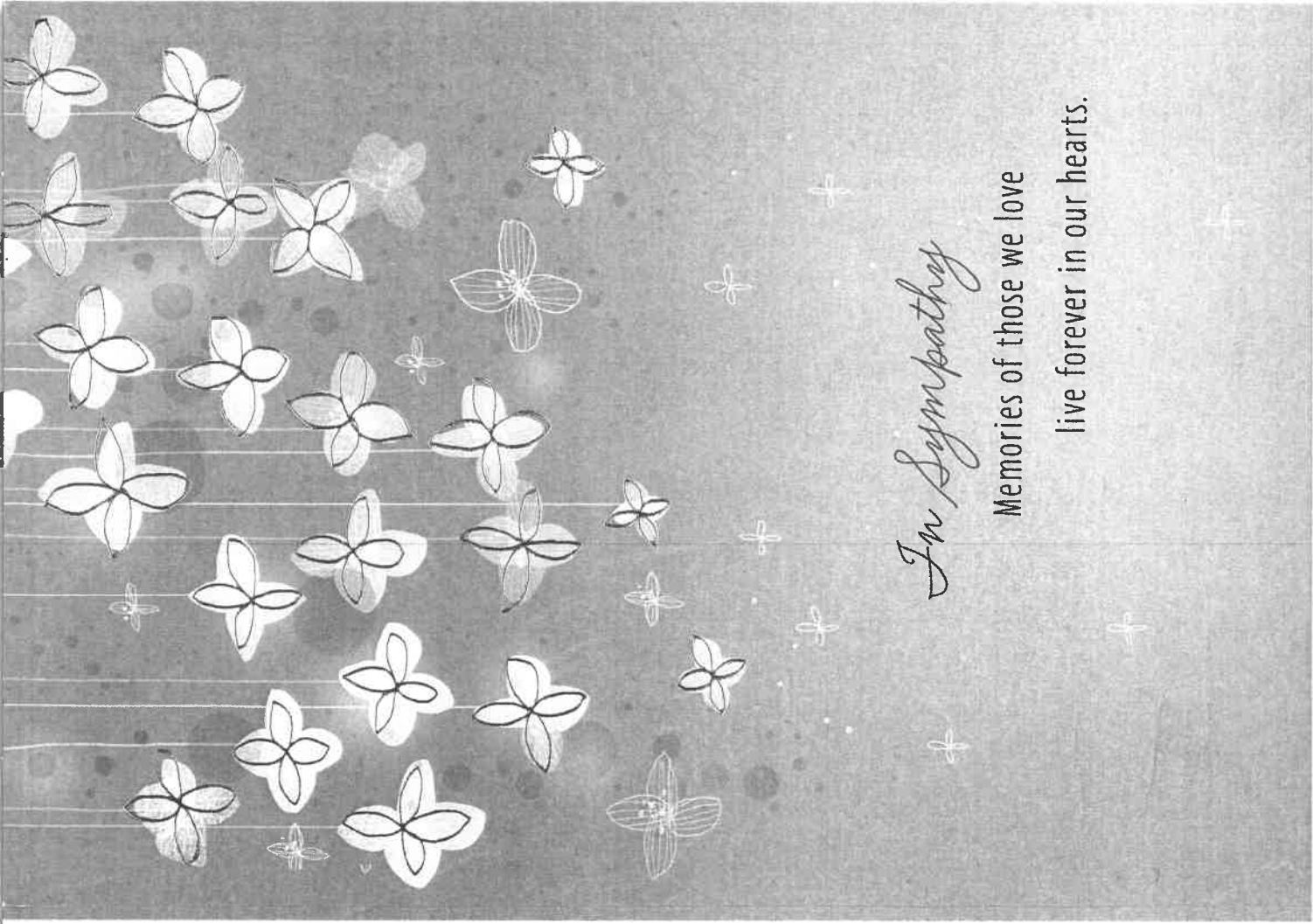

Academic Senate representation possibilities October 17, 2023

Option 1. – No change. Does NOT require a Constitutional Amendment.

Option 2. – Change from school to ACC only; keep previous schools as units. Keep Chino, Fontana, At-Large, and Adjunct At-Large senator spots. Requires a Constitutional Amendment to change the language describing representation from school and/or unit to something else.

- Stays relatively the same:
 - Keep Fontana and Chino as separate units.
 - Reclassify Student Services and Instructional Support as “units” and keep the current structure. Rename Student Services as Academic and Career Counseling.
 - Retain alternate senators.
- Changes:
 - KNA merges with HS (loss of 2 senators).
 - VPA merges with Language Arts representation (loss of 2 senators).
 - BAT splits into MIT & BTH (gain of 2 senators).
- Unresolved
 - Where does HFIC fit? HFIC is not an ACC. Would this need to be a separate unit since HFIC doesn't belong to an ACC.
 - Where does Athletics go?

Option 3. – Representation by ACC and unit sizes. Requires a Constitutional Amendment. The following option was produced using the number of representatives per area determined by the size of that area. Retain the Chino, Fontana, At-Large, and Adjunct At-Large positions.

Areas that have between

- 20-16 programs having 4 reps
- 15-11 programs having 3 reps
- 10-1 programs having 2 reps (2 reps would be a minimum for an area)

ACD has the most programs (17), followed by PSC (16), BTH & HW are tied (13), then STEM (11), MIT (9), Academic & Career Counseling (7), Instructional Support (4), and HFIC (4)

- This structure does not apply to Chino and Fontana as those are campus representations rather than program representations. The 2 reps minimum would apply.
- Retain the three Senator At-Large positions
- Retain the two Adjunct At-Large positions
- Retain alternate representatives
