5. Guided Pathways: The Chair reminded the committee of the April 17, 2018 FLEX Extravaganza. Morning activities will focus on backwards design for program pathways (e.g. instructional, instructional support, counseling/advising, student services, etc.). Cindy Walker will provide an overview and materials to the Deans at the Dean's meeting next week. The Chair offered to assist Angela Burk-Herrick in developing the templates. The afternoon FLEX workshop will focus on "Areas of Interest" (aka meta-major) development.

6. Miscellaneous:

- **6.1.** The Chair distributed the Ellucian/Colleague Steering Committee Notes and asked the committee to take a survey of the links they do not use.
- **6.2.** Dr. Randall initiated the conversation on the advisories in the Math Courses discussed at the last curriculum meeting. She has some concerns about leaving advisories on the CORs. There will be a number of students who will not need the advisory; as a result, the advisory appearing during registration may be misleading. Rob Kopp mentioned that the coordinators and Math faculty would like to keep these advisories. The wording on the assessment is set to guide students with recommendations and placement options. Some committee members suggested that the Math department put the wording housed in the assessment on the COR in Curricunet and in Colleague as an alternate option to having the advisories. Lucy Serrano mentioned that counselors do not express that an advisory is needed, but rather they discuss the options on an individual basis. Megan Keebler shared that students will be able to take an SI session even if their class does not have an SI Leader in order to support the AB-705 efforts; however, this is in development. Rob Kopp will bring these concerns back to the Math department for further discussion.
- 7. Consent Agenda: The consent agenda was approved 13/0/0.
 - **7.1.** KINACT-26, KINACT-28A, and KINACT-32 were added back to the Kinesiology ADT which was approved at the March 21, 2018 meeting. The three courses were removed pending confirmation of articulation agreements to submit to the Chancellor's Office for approval. The Articulation Officer has provided documentation to show articulation of these courses.
