1. Call To Order/New Committee Members: The meeting was called to order at 1:34p.m.
2. Public Comment: No comment.
3. Review and Approval of October 21, 2020 Expanded Summary Notes: The summary notes were approved 18/0/0.

## 4. Curriculum Office Reports

4.1. Curriculum Chair: The Chair shared that courses that were offered in summer and/or fall 2020 via a DE modality, that have not been approved for a DE modality, must be launched and approved for DE by the Governing Board by December 2020. These courses will be fast tracked through the Tech Review process and will be read by the Curriculum Chair only. The courses will then appear on the consent agenda for the Curriculum Committee Review. This process reflects the same
process taken in Spring 2020 and is being implemented so the college can meet the December 2020 deadline for the Chancellor's Office Emergency DE Addendum.
4.2. Curriculum Specialist: As of the October 30, 2020 deadline, there were 290 courses submitted and 71 programs submitted. As of yesterday, there are 315 courses and 75 programs. The Curriculum Specialist reminded the Committee that the Curriculum Office and the Committee process curriculum throughout the academic year. The timelines established are for the catalog and schedule coordination. The Catalog and Schedule Coordinator can answer questions in regards to which curriculum will make the schedule or catalog.

The Specialist also reminded the Committee of the processing workflow of curriculum after curriculum committee approval that was shared at the retreat. Notices of Chancellor's Office (CO) approvals will no longer be sent to faculty, deans, and other members of the campus by the Specialist. In the past, this has caused great confusion in thinking that a course or program was ready to publicize and/or schedule. CO approval is actually the first step in moving towards scheduling and publication, and this cannot happen until the Catalog and Schedule Coordinator processes the curriculum. As a result, Ryan Sipma will be the one to inform faculty, deans, coordinators, AAlls, and Student Services of completed curricular changes.
4.3. Catalog and Schedule Coordinator: Ryan Sipma encouraged the committee to ask him any questions regarding the Scheduling and Catalog process.

Stephen Calebotta shared that The English Department has not yet agreed on how ENGL-495 should be coded for basic skills and/or degree applicability. Laura Hope told Stephen Calebotta that a decision would need to be made by February.

The Math department agreed that the coding for MATH-420 should be basic skills and the course is not degree applicable. The Math department would also like to keep their 400 level numbering on this course.
