7. Discussion Items:

- **7.1.** Curriculum Institute July 7-9, 2021 2021 Curriculum Institute Registration & Information: The Specialist shared that the Curriculum Institute will be July 7-9, 2021 virtually. All information for the institution is linked. The Chair asked committee members to reach out to the Curriculum Office if they are interested in attending.
- **7.2. Distance Education AP and META Page:** The Chair shared modifications to the DE page in META that included the revisions recommended at the last meeting. The Chair wanted the committee to discuss the two options:
 - 1. Option 1: Faculty are asked on the DE page if there are any sample class assignments that would need to be modified for DE modalities and to explain those modifications.
 - 2. Option 2: The faculty will be asked to confirm on the Class Assignments page that the assignments listed are appropriate for all modalities.

Discussion ensued on both options. Some members feel option 1 promotes more nuances and richer thinking on class assignments in DE modalities. While other members felt option 1 may be cumbersome for some programs that require resources and equipment for assignments. A member suggested describing the question more broadly so that faculty do not feel the need to put specifics in their assignments that may call for continuous changes to the COR, such as "Describe *typical* modifications that *could be done* in DE modalities..." Another member suggested having a section for face-to-face assignments and a section for sample DE assignments. The committee also discussed that DE questions can be moved to the forefront of the curriculum development process in META. Discussion ensued on different ideas to combine both options in META. The Chair suggested to the committee that she and the Curriculum Specialist take the recommendations and create a technical solution in META that addresses the needs discussed.

- **7.3. Ethnic Studies Workgroup Update:** The workgroup had an initial "get to know you" meeting and will continue to meet in the semester.
- **8. Next Agenda Forecast:** The next agenda will include an abundant number of programs for review in hopes that these programs will be updated in time for the electronic catalog pull in META.
