- After committee discussion, it was decided that the Chair will put out a call for another round of nominations for faculty representatives in these areas.

7.2. Academic Senate Resolution on Climate Change & Carbon Neutral Campus

- Following an overview of the resolution and Academic Senate discussion by Academic Senate President, Neil Watkins, the Curriculum Committee discussed possible next steps in response to the Academic Senate Resolution, particularly related to encouraging "faculty to include lessons and assignments on climate change, sustainability, environmental ethics, climate justice, and related issues into their courses."
- Curriculum representatives Joann Eisberg and Kathy Galipeau provided examples of assignments they use in their courses. It was suggested that prompts within the course modules linked to related resources that the Faculty Success Center is working on, should be considered. It was noted that because of the connections between DEI and environmental justice, these prompts might simply we included in the DEI framework.
- The Curriculum Chair shared plans to more intentionally incorporate sustainability/environmental responsibility in the revision of Institutional Learning Outcomes (ILOs). Neil Watkins and OAC Tri-Chair, Shannon Jessen shared that there already is a natural fit with the Community/Global Awareness and Responsibility ILO. Shannon Jessen also encouraged faculty to link sustainability, climate justice, and other related assignments to Social/Global Awareness ACES-ILO rubrics in Canvas and share the assignments in the Canvas Commons with an ACES tag.
- Because there is only one more committee meeting remains this semester, the committee agreed to pick up this discussion in the fall.
