INDUSTRIAL ELECTRICAL TECHNOLOGY PACKAGE

This new course is designed to create more opportunities for students to receive workplace safety skills in the field. Students can also take the current OSHA course, but the OSHA course can only be taught by an OSHA certified instructor which limits course offerings for students. Employers in the industry and employers on the IET advisory committee state that they do not necessarily require OSHA training; however, they do require workplace safety skills and knowledge in general, whether it be through OSHA certification or another course. The need for workplace safety can now be achieved with this new course as well.

NURSING: ASSOCIATE DEGREE PACKAGE

The Chair worked with Lisa Doget on incorporating the existing DEI practices in the classroom into the COR. Lisa Doget shared that implicit bias training is mandated early on in the program. The students also engage in case studies where they utilize cultural competence and culturally sensitive language. Students are also asked to reflect on their biases and how to mitigate biases as a nurse. Lisa and the Chair updated assignments throughout the CORs to reflect their DEI practices. Lisa shared with the committee more examples of how DEI is incorporated into the classroom and how cultural competence is assessed. For example, students practice asking patients what their pronouns are and use their pronouns during patient care.

NURSING: VOCATIONAL PACKAGE

The Specialist shared that she and the Chair worked with Shelley Eckvahl in incorporating the many DEI practices already done in the classroom into the COR. The Nursing Vocational team already includes DEI assignments for every course. The Curriculum Office worked with Shelley to input some of these DEI assignments into the core courses in each semester of the program. The assignments include students reflecting on their biases and personal opinions and how biases affect patient care. They also reflect and write about the importance of being culturally competent nurses. Shelley also minimized gender specific language by changing "mother" to "child bearer" throughout the NURVN-421 and NURVN-421L CORs. Candice Piper, who attended the curriculum meeting, emphasized how dedicated the team is to incorporating DEI into the classroom for students.

The Committee commended all three nursing areas on their exemplar use of DEI in both the classroom and in their curriculum.
