- 1. Call to Order/Roll Call: The meeting was called to order at 1:34p.m.
- 2. Public Comment (Reserved for guests to address any item on the agenda for a limit of two minutes): None.
- 3. Review and Approval of November 16, 2022 Expanded Summary Notes: The summary notes were approved 15/0/1.
- 4. Curriculum Office Reports
 - **4.1.** Curriculum Chair: The Chair shared that the committee only has one more week of reading this semester and thanked them for all of their amazing work. The committee has gone through majority of the curriculum packages for the MIT, PCS, and HWA standard update cycle with only a handful remaining for January.

- **4.4.** Articulation Officer (AO): No report.
- **4.5.** Chief Instructional Officer (CIO)/Designee of CIO: Dean Rundquist thanked the Curriculum Committee for their hard work on all of their readings and suggestions. He also thanked the Curriculum Team for their hard work on keeping the curriculum process on track.

5. Workgroup Updates:

- **5.1.** META Workgroup: The group will provide the Curriculum Office the suggestions made for the META pages by the end of the week.
- **5.2.** DEI Workgroup: The workgroup will meet next week.
- **5.3.** Handbook Workgroup: No update this week.
- **6.** Consent Agenda: The consent agenda was approved 17/0/0.
 - **6.1.** In consultation with discipline faculty, the AO revised the Social Justice Studies AA-T TMC Template (approved September 21, 2022) to remove ARTH-3 from Area 3 (Social Sciences), and appropriately place it in Area 2 (Arts and Humanities). The changes were reflected in META as well.
 - **6.2.** Per request from the Chancellor's Office, the title of the Social Justice Studies AA-T must be changed to "Social Justice Studies, General" since there are now new emphases in the Social Justice Studies templates. The title has been changed.

7. Curriculum Proposals:

ECONOMICS PACKAGE

The Chair shared the <u>Economics Program Presentation</u> that covers the highlights, accomplishments, and labor market data for the program. A member asked if students are aware of the specific institutions local degrees transfer to if a four-year institution is specified. For the Political Economics degree, there is a direct transfer to the Political Economics degree at CSU San Bernardino. Joan Godinez agreed that including this information on academic maps and/or the description would be helpful for students.

During the curriculum committee review of ECON-8, it was recommended that either the title of ECON-8 specify "Western History of Economic Ideas" based upon the content, or if not, perhaps the course could include a more diverse array of economic theorists that better represents global perspectives on the economy. The discipline faculty member provided a thoughtful and detailed response to the committee that stated that a title change would not appropriately reflect the subject matter of the course because economic ideas are not limited to a geographic location or a particular culture. While the faculty member agrees that a more diverse array of economic theorists would be ideal, this course focuses on the three major Schools of Economic Thought that are used globally. Curriculum Committee members agreed to respect the faculty's expertise in the subject matter; however, they encourage the faculty to continue exploring how to incorporate more diverse economic theorists into the course.

The committee discussed their interest in collaborating with Academic Senate to create DEIA consultants. While all faculty this cycle have made great strides in incorporating DEIA into their CORs, the committee recognizes that there are still opportunities for improvement. The committee explored the idea of DEIA consultants that would potentially collaborate with faculty during the curriculum process to research DEIA in their disciplines. The Academic Senate and the Curriculum Committee will discuss this topic more in the spring.

8.1. Dual Enrollment Presentation: CTE Liaison and Automotive Faculty, Johnny Polidano, presented information on Dual Enrollment as a member of the Dual Enrollment Committee. The number of dual enrollment students has doubled across the state and continues to increase. In 2022, Chaffey has over 3000 students enrolled in dual enrollment, a significant increase from the few hundred enrollments in 2016. The Dual Enrollment Committee is working on academic maps specifically made for students in Chaffey's Dual Enrollment program. He provided an example map. The Dual Enrollment committee hopes to create maps in all dual enrollment areas in the future.
