1. **Call to Order/Roll Call:** The meeting was called to order at 1:35p.m.
2. **Public Comment** (Reserved for guests to address any item on the agenda for a limit of two minutes): None.
3. **Review and Approval of September 20, 2023 Expanded Summary Notes:** The summary notes were approved 13/0/0.
4. **Curriculum Office Reports**

4.1. Curriculum Chair:

1. **Clarification on Zero Textbook Costs vs Zero Resource Costs for Students:** The Chair shared the Committee's discussion on how to better clarify course costs for students to Academic Senate. A committee is currently working on ZTC and low cost resources and will work on language that helps with that clarity.
2. **DEIA:** The Chair also shared the Committee's request for institutional DEIA definitions to Academic Senate. The Academic Senate President sent an email calling for faculty volunteers to be on that workgroup.

4.2. Curriculum Specialist: No report.

4.3. Catalog and Schedule Coordinator: The Catalog and Schedule Coordinator shared that the addendum to the catalog was [published online](#) on October 13, 2023. The Schedule of Classes for spring 2024 will be posted online on October 23, 2023.

4.4. Articulation Officer (AO): The state requested a Fall 2027 implementation date (as opposed to Fall 2024) for Common Course Numbering (AB 1111). The AO also shared the latest updates on CalGETC. The Oral Communication Studies classes will no longer require ENGL-1A as a prerequisite, but they will need to be resubmitted for CalGETC approval. However, ENGL-1A does have to be a prerequisite for courses in Area 1C. **Note:** COMSTD-72, PHIL 75, or PHIL 76 already meet this requirement. CalGETC submission will be required December 2024. It is highly likely that IGETC will be grandfathered in for CalGETC (at least initially) which will not require resubmissions. The goal is to have the first wave of CalGETC grandfathered in from IGETC.

4.5. Chief Instructional Officer (CIO)/Designee of CIO: Dean Rundquist reported that there is a taskforce that has been created to elevate the Ethnic Studies program. The Chancellor’s Office has provided a small grant to colleges to develop and work on their Ethnic Studies program. A TMC for Ethnic Studies is also being finalized statewide.

5. Consent Agenda: The consent agenda was approved 14/0/0.

5.1. PTA-32 and PTA-33 Clean-up (Clinical Courses for Physical Therapy Assistant Program)

1. Course type changed from “Laboratory” to “Work Experience”
2. Units changed to 5.5 units based upon new work experience units to hours calculations (264-297 hours)

CULINARY PACKAGE

The Chair shared the [Culinary Program Presentation](#) that highlights the program’s accomplishments, labor market analysis, and DEIA inclusion. The Culinary Arts, Baking & Patisserie Programs take a cross-cultural and inclusive approach to the study of Culinary Arts - Baking & Patisserie from a worldview perspective. The faculty shared that the courses allow for the investigation of a broader view of practices that are not solely focused on classic French & Italian techniques. Class assignments demonstrate how instructors can create assignments with DEI principles in mind and how students can actively engage with topics that might reflect their own lived experiences and/or challenge their preconceived notions of interior design and client needs.

GUIDANCE PACKAGE

The Articulation Officer who is also Guidance Faculty responded to the Committee's questions regarding these courses. One question was whether discussing achievement gaps as a content item would be beneficial to students. She shared that they do cover structural, systemic, personal, and emotional educational barriers. They also define the various forms of success for students and how success can be achieved in many different ways. The Chair commended the AO for changing the term "probation" to "academic standing" in GUID-507.

Another question was asked as to whether Guidance students are required to take Success Center hours. GUID-507 used to have a Success Center requirement. The other guidance courses did not. Students are encouraged to use the Success Centers, especially for workshops. Christina Holdiness shared that not having these supplemental hours on the CORs impacts funding for the Success Center. If Success Center attendance is a component of any course in any discipline, it is recommended that this is inputted in the COR to help with that funding.
