Academic Community Employability Skills (ACES)

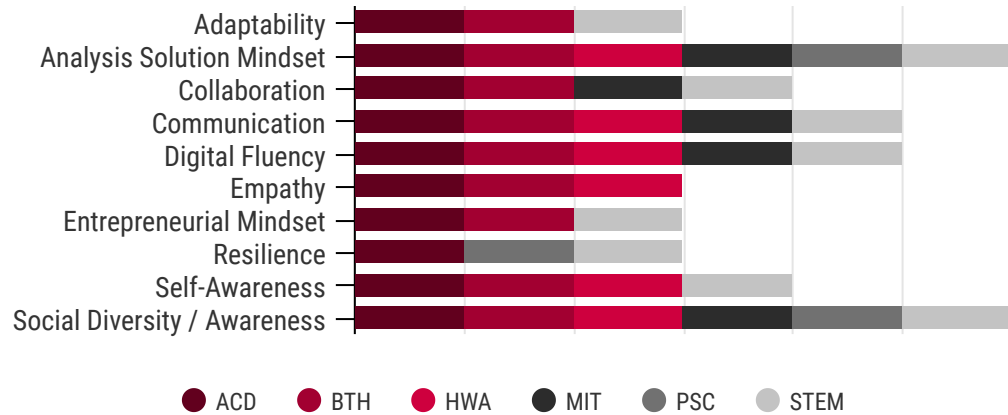
Overview: The Office of Institutional Research collaborated with the Outcomes & Assessment Committee to examine the implementation of ACES. [ACES](#) are a set of 10 transferable skills that are highly valued by employers and advanced programs of study. Each skill has four associated outcomes that have been aligned with Chaffey's Institutional Learning Outcomes. All of the [Academic and Career Communities](#) have incorporated ACES.

All ACCs have assessed "Analysis Solution Mindset" and "Social Diversity / Awareness"

5 out of 6 ACCs have incorporated at least 5 of the 10 ACES in their courses

There has been a 67% increase in assignments aligned with ACES from 2020-21 to 2021-22

ACES by Academic and Career Communities (ACCs)

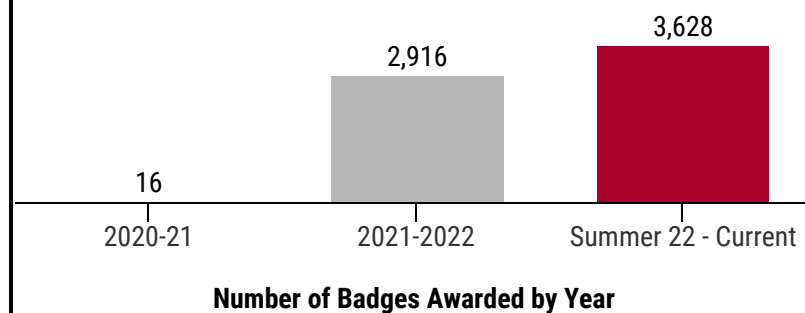
