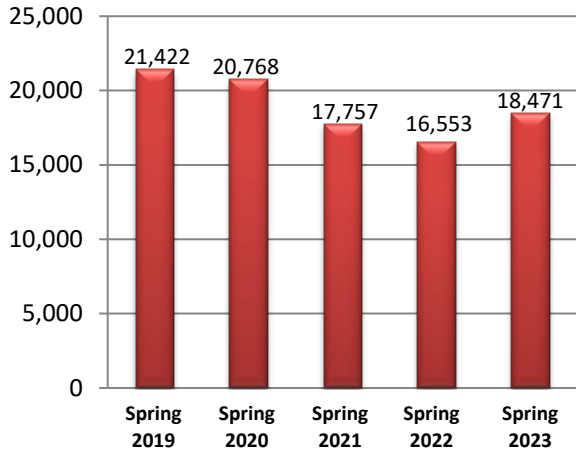

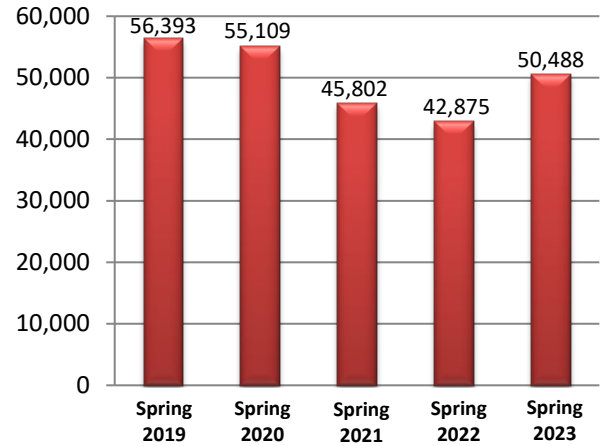
Unduplicated Student Headcount



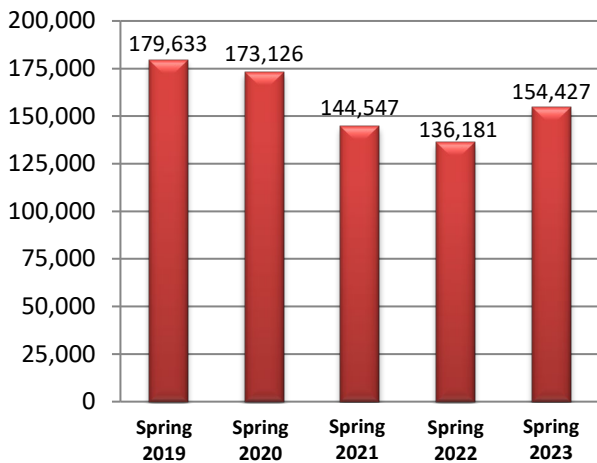
← 1,918 more credit students than last spring (+11.6%)

Number of Credit Enrollments



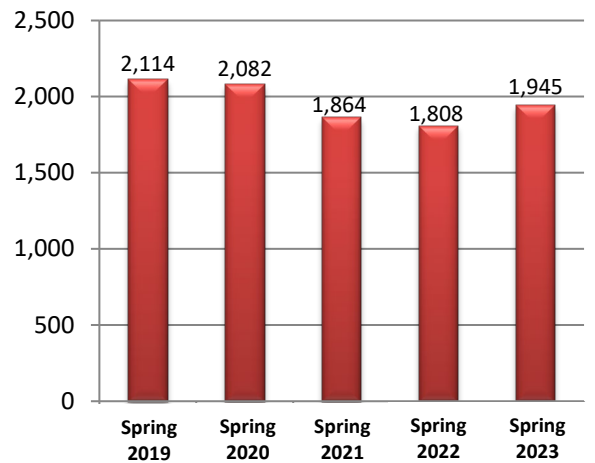
Total Credit Units Attempted



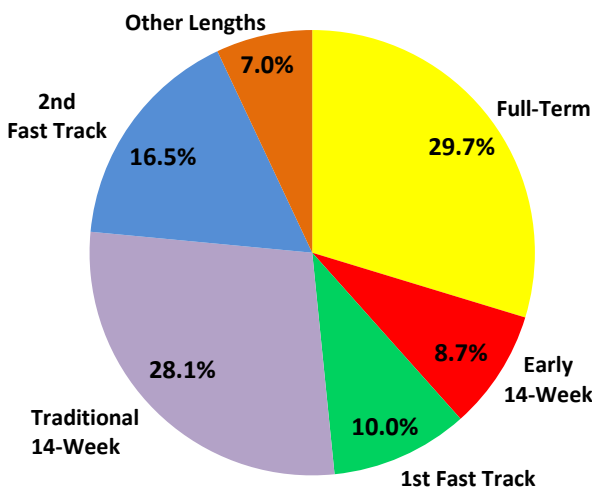
← 18,246 more units attempted by students than last spring (+13.4%)

Number of Credit Sections Offered

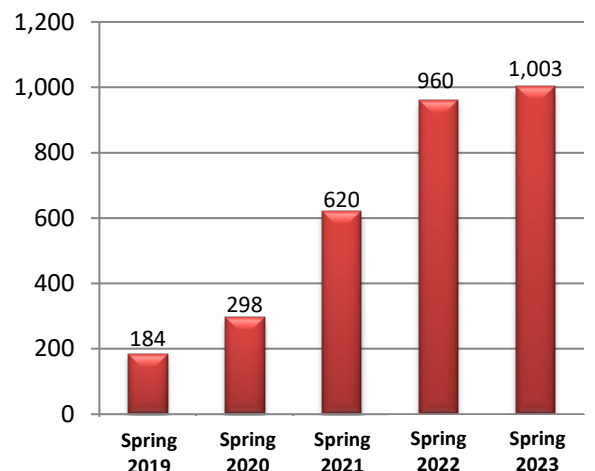


Section Distribution by Session Length

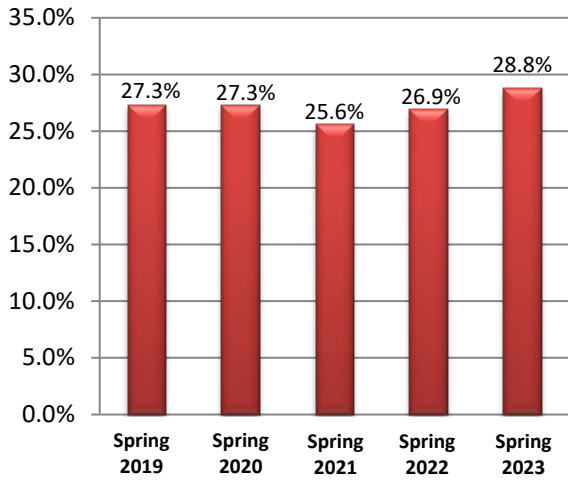
Number of Late Start Sections

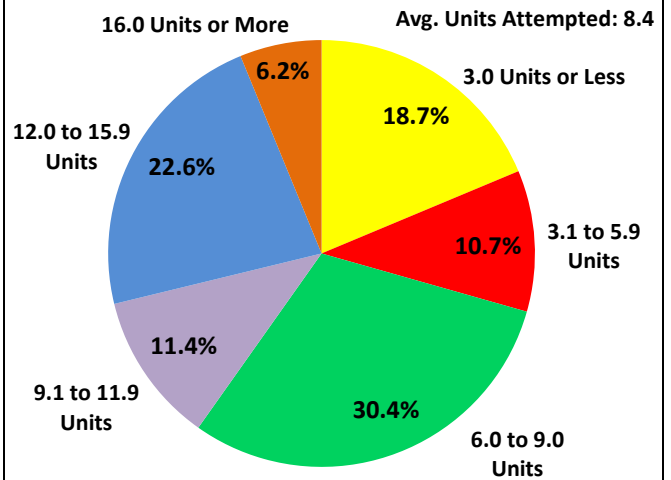
Full-Time Student Enrollment Comparison



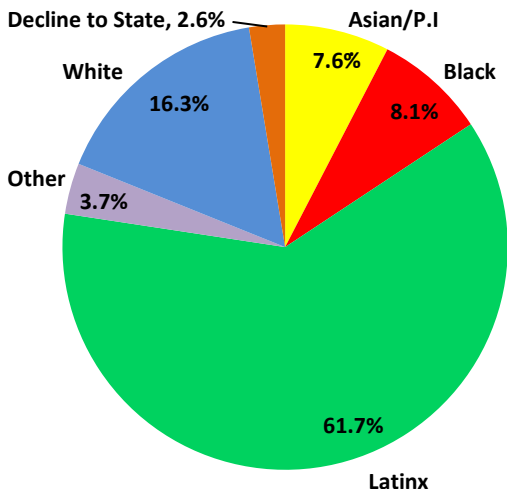
← 5,323 students are enrolled full-time, a 19.5% increase over last spring. This also represents the highest % of full-time students since spring 2013.

Units Attempted, Spring 2023



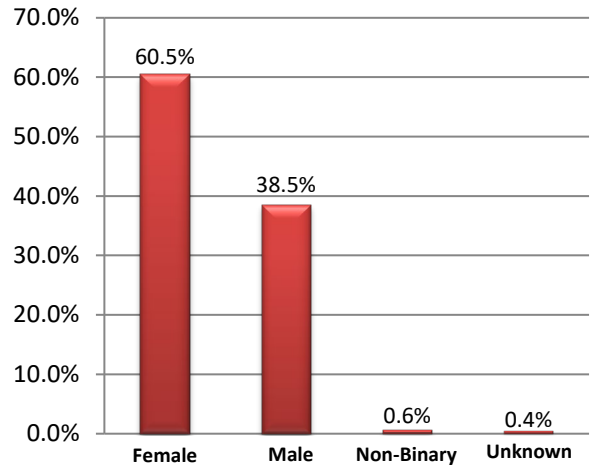
Student Ethnicity



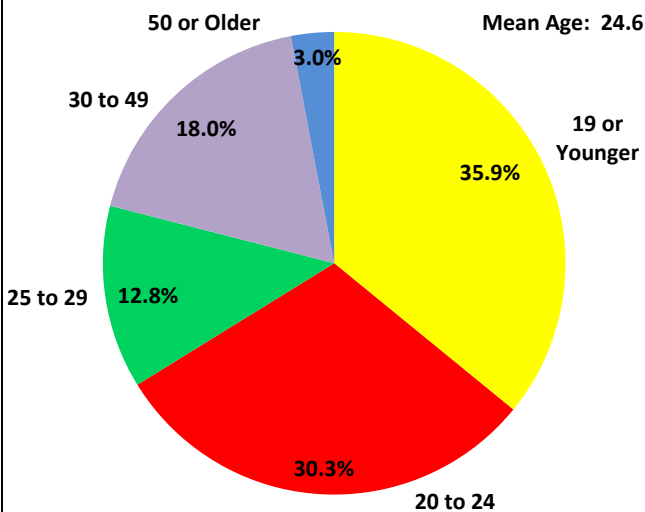
← 81.1% of students are from historically under-represented student populations, (last spring: 82.7%).
