



AP 3500 Campus Safety

A Campus Safety Plan shall be developed and made available on the Campus Police website.

The Chief of Police prepares and annually updates a report of all occurrences reported to the Campus Police Department of arrests for crimes that are committed on or adjacent to District property and that involve violence, hate violence, theft or destruction of property, illegal drugs, or alcohol intoxication, and of all occurrences of noncriminal acts of hate violence reported to campus authorities. A written report will be submitted to the Governing Board.

Written records of noncriminal acts of hate violence as defined in Education Code Section 67380 shall include, at a minimum, a description of the act of hate violence, the victim characteristics, and offender characteristics, if known.
