



BP 3050 Institutional Code of Ethics

The District's Institutional Code of Ethics is developed to promote the District's Mission Statement and Core Values and support the expectation that District employees will indeed act with integrity in the public interest. The Institutional Code of Ethics is designed to align with the Governing Board Ethics and Conflict of Interest Policy, the Faculty Senate's Faculty Ethics Statement, the Student Code of Conduct, and the employment group agreements and plans.

All District employees are expected to act in an ethical manner exhibiting fair, honest, trustworthy, dispassionate, and unprejudiced behavior. The ethical employee must be conspicuously consistent in the exercise of the aforementioned behaviors, upholding the public's trust, maintaining integrity, and sustaining credibility and accountability.
