



## **BP 3570 Smoking on Campus**

Chaffey College is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for its students, employees, and visitors. The Chaffey College Governing Board and its students, faculty, and staff recognize the serious health problems associated with the use of smoking tobacco, other non-tobacco smoking products, or smokeless tobacco. Therefore, the Governing Board prohibits the use of these products on property owned, leased, or operated by the District, except as outlined in Administrative Procedure 3570, which designates approved smoking areas. Furthermore, smoking is not allowed in District owned, operated or leased vehicles.

For the purposes of this policy, smoking shall mean all uses of tobacco, including but not limited to cigars, cigarettes, pipes, e-cigarettes, and chewing tobacco. Marijuana use remains prohibited under the student behavior code and other applicable laws. The sale of any of these products is prohibited on District owned, operated or leased property or vehicles.
