- i. Senator Rita motioned 16 people to go to SSCCC and the cost of attending will be around \$10,660. Senator Sanchez seconded the motion.
- ii. Senator Rita amended the \$10,660 to 12,000 to attend the SSCCC including the transportation, registration, hotel, and diem. Senator Sanchez second. Vote 6-0.
- iii. Senator Awad amended the \$12,000 to \$17,000 including the transportation, registration, hotel, and diem for the SSCCC in Riverside. Senator Shalabi second the motion. Vote 6-0.
