

Dear Campus Community:

Due to the ongoing Omicron surge, Chaffey College will make the following modifications to the spring 2022 semester:

- The attached **List A** of sections temporarily online will remain in that modality through Friday, February 25, 2022. Faculty should notify their students via email of this change.
- The attached **List B** of 14-week sections will begin the semester remotely from Monday, January 31 through Friday, February 25, 2022. Classes will meet online as scheduled, and faculty should notify their students via email of this change.
- Many essential career education courses and labs will continue in their current modality.
- Counseling, Library and Success Center work/appointments will remain available online only through Friday, February 25, 2022. These employees will continue to report onsite as scheduled and conduct their work online during this time.
- Managers will be scheduling classified professionals in accordance with safety protocols.
- During this time, all meetings among employees and/or with students will be conducted remotely.
- Employees who are required to test for COVID-19 must continue to follow testing protocols during this time.
- All employees are required to wear minimum 3-ply face coverings indoors, such as disposal surgical/medical masks, while working on-site in any Chaffey College facility. The District has these masks available for all members of our campus community.
