The following email has been sent to all students on behalf of Alisha Rosas:

Dear Chaffey Student,

Thank you for choosing Chaffey College. For the past two years, the College has worked diligently to provide you with resources to help you throughout the pandemic. Using federal money (HEERF) designated for pandemic relief, we have been able to provide students with loaner Chromebooks, COVID-19 WiFi hotspots, Campus Store grants and free lunches, among other resources of support.

The federal funding was first provided to the College in spring 2020. The College is proud to share that it has fully spent the allocated funds available to help support thousands of students during the pandemic.

Naturally, the exhaustion of these funds impacts the availability and sustainability of such pandemic-related resources. **At the end of this month, May 31, 2022, the following will no longer be available or in service:**

- COVID-19 WiFi hotspots (you DO NOT need to turn in your device)
- Campus Store grants
- Free lunches

The College will continue to offer loaner Chromebooks to students who remain enrolled. Also, parking is free during the summer term. Students can utilize the College's WiFi via its parking lots on all three campuses:

- Rancho Cucamonga Lots: R4, R18, R19
- Fontana: F1
- Chino C4
