As part of the District's continued commitment to keep you informed about developments related to COVID-19, we share the following information: An employee who was present in the Financial Aid office on Thursday, July 8 has tested positive for COVID-19. Another employee who last worked onsite on Monday, July 19 in the Skills Lab has also tested positive for COVID-19. Both employees will not return to campus until medical clearance has been secured. All employees who had close contact with these employees have been notified.
