CRIMINAL JUSTICE PACKAGE

The Chair shared the <u>Criminal Justice and Homeland National Security Program Presentation</u> that highlights the programs' accomplishments, labor market data, and program outlooks and recommendations. After the presentation, the Specialist shared that CJ faculty, Ana Rosales, Stephen Lux, and Barbara Ray made the committee's recommended changes to CJ-7, CJ-51, CJ-55, and CJ-410. The Chair also thanked the committee for their comments on CLOs. She will catalog them to provide to discipline faculty.

Discussion began with members commending the CJ faculty on how they integrated equity throughout their CORs and their responsiveness to social justice matters in their curriculum. A member mentioned that some courses explicitly state equity in their learning outcomes, but equity topics could be incorporated more into the content of the CORs. She also noticed that some CORs had descriptions that were topic-based statements and suggested restructuring the descriptions to be clearer for students. The Curriculum Office will take these comments back to the CJ faculty.

The discussion then focused on a general discussion of DEI in all CORs at Chaffey. Members discussed how the content page in META could provide better guidance on how to incorporate DEI into content, and in general, how to structure the content section for the COR.

CJ faculty, Ana Rosales, attended the meeting and thanked the committee for their thorough review and feedback.

PSYCHOLOGY PACKAGE

The AO shared the Psychology Program Presentation that highlights the program's accomplishments, labor market data, and program outlooks and recommendations.

Discussion began with the Academic Senate President commending the Psychology department on their outstanding increase in awards given and their reduction in units. The AO also shared the committee's commendations on PSYCH-41 (the resources used to help cut costs for students) and PSYCH-80 (their inclusion of DEI is a model for others).

Because community college curriculum committees are charged with minimizing duplicate curriculum, a committee member sought clarification on how SCSCI-10 is different from STAT-10 because the two courses have similar descriptions, the same number of units, and share the same C-ID designation.

The discussion that followed clarified that (1) SCSCI-10 has 3 units of lecture and a one-unit lab, whereas STAT 10 has 4 units of lecture, and (2) SCSCI-10 focuses on applying statistics to social science research, whereas STAT 10 does not focus on social science application, nor does it teach students to use SPSS software for analysis. These differences in SCSCI-10 and STAT 10 are the reason the Psychology department requires SCSCI-10, and not STAT-10, as a prerequisite for their research methods course (PSYCH-80). The AO and the Chair have met with Psychology faculty in the past to discuss the concern that students who take STAT-10 do not satisfy the prerequisite requirement for PSYCH-80. This results in the Psychology Coordinator receiving numerous prerequisite challenge requests for PSYCH-80 from students who took STAT-10.

Committee members expressed concern about students majoring in Psychology having to take SCSCI-10 after completing STAT 10 in order to take PSYCH-80, which is a degree requirement. (The AO shared that many students in this situation will simply take their required research methods course (PSYCH-80 equivalent) at another community college that has STAT-10 as the prerequisite). The committee then discussed possible curricular solutions. Some members asked if the one-unit lab portion of SCSCI-10 could be a separate concurrent course for students that could be taken separately to appropriately prepare STAT-10 completers for PSYCH-80. Another suggestion was to modify PSYCH-80 to include the essential content of the lab portion of SCSCI-10 in the first few weeks of the PSYCH-80 course. Committee members expressed concerns about the barriers for students if no changes are made to SCSCI-10 and/or PSYCH-80. The committee agreed that, at the very least, more details should be added to the SCSCI-10 description and content to make it clear to students that the course is a research-based class that leads into PSYCH-80.

The motion to approve the Psychology and Social Science Packages was amended to remove PSYCH-80, SCSCI-10, and the Psychology AS-T. The Chair, AO, and Specialist agreed to take this feedback back to the Psychology department.
