

AP 5220 Shower Facilities for Homeless Students

The District maintains shower facilities for student use on campus that may be used by any homeless student who is in good standing with the District. A student is defined as anyone with a valid Chaffey College student identification number.

A homeless student is defined as a student who does not have a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This includes, but is not limited to, students who: are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.

Shower facilities are located in the Earl Sicosky Gymnasium on the Rancho Campus (5885 Haven Avenue, Rancho Cucamonga CA 91737-3002) and are open for use by homeless students from 7:30 a.m. to 9:50 p.m., Monday through Friday. In the event that these hours conflict with the hours of an intercollegiate athletic program, the District will post the time of the conflict, notifying students of shower facilities availability.
