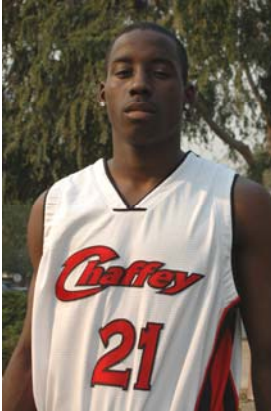


Men's Basketball Battles #1 Fullerton
