Then in the 7th, Willie Holmes scored on an RBI by Jonathan Costantino taking the score to 2-0. First up to bat in the 8th, Ryan Delgado homered over the centerfield wall taking the Panthers to 3-0. Then in the top of the 9th, the Pirates scored 3 on a homer by Jose Vargas, tying the game at 3-3. In the 10th, Ventura scored again on a Tyler Bevan RBI. The Panthers pulled out all stops in the bottom of the 10th scoring 2 when Michael Suring brought in Mychal Johnson and Ryan Delgado to
