Jimmy is a 1968 graduate of Rubidoux High school (all-CIF), who also attended Riverside Community College '69-70 (state finalist). Jimmy continued his education at UCLA graduating with a B.S. in Kinesiology in 1973. An All-American wrestler at RCC and UCLA, an MVP at both schools, a Pacific 8 place winner AND an NCAA finalist his senior year, Jimmy was the first in Riverside to successfully
