Former Panther drafted to the Albany Patroons

The Albany Patroons are pleased to announce that Haron Hargrave, a 5'11" guard from Sacramento State, is the team's sixth draft pick in the 2007 CBA College Entry Draft. Hargrave played in 26 games for the Hornets, leading the team in points per game (13.8), free throws (119), and free throw percentage (.821). He also had 1.8 steals per game, fourth best in the Big Sky Conference. In a game against Illinois State, he achieved eight steals, the second-highest single-game mark in Sacramento State history.
