This win, coupled with Grossmont's loss over the weekend bump the Panthers into 3rd place in the conference and 16th in southern California.

The Panthers travel to Antelope Valley Saturday for their final game of the 2007 regular season. The Marauders are undefeated this season and are ranked first in conference and 10th in the state with an 8-0 record.
