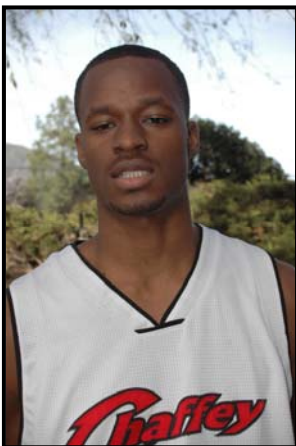
WOMEN'S BASKETBALL WINS CHAMPIONSHIP AT CONOCO PHILLIPS INVITATIONAL



The Chaffey women were on the road last weekend, participating in the annual Conoco Phillips Invitational at Cuesta College. The women defeated Alan Hancock Thursday 87-47 to advance to the semifinals Friday against Citrus. In a 70-63 win against the Fighting Owls, the Panthers were again led by sophomore Aundria Anderson who had 11 points, 8 rebounds and 2 assists, advancing the women to the championship game against LA Pierce who had beat Cuesta 72-59 in their semifinal round. Saturday, Chaffey beat Pierce 74-71 recovering from a 13 point deficit at halftime to win their first Conoco Phillips title since 2004. The Panthers were led by guard Tamesha Jackson who scored 16 points in the LA Pierce game and was named tournament MVP. Fellow guard, Arielle McClellan was named to the all-tournament team. The women take on Grossmont Thursday in round 1 of the Irvine Valley Tournament, where they are the 2-time defending champions.

MEN'S BASKETBALL WINS CHAMPIONSHIP AT GROSSMONT TOURNAMENT

The CHP have moved up to #8 in the state and #4 in Southern California as of the December 7th Coaches' Poll!



The men started off the Grossmont Tournament slow trailing Southwestern 21-9, 12 minutes into the first game of the tournament, but rallied late in the half to take the lead against the Jaguars eventually winning 96-74. On Day 2, the Panthers took down Cuesta 79-73 for the 8th game that the CHP was able to hold an opponent to less than 75 points. Although Cuesta led for the majority of the game a press by the Panthers (11-5) gave Chaffey the victory advancing them to the finals against Cypress (Chaffey beat Cypress on 11/14 in 2OT). Against Cypress, the CHP once again fell behind at the start but fought back to lead at the 1/2 47-42. The Panthers led for the remainder of the game, winning 97-85. All 15 players played last weekend, contributing to the tournament win. Lamar Williams was named tournament MVP. After battling stomach flu, Winston Robinson is back. He made all tournament and was 20/22 from the line for the tournament. The Chaffey Panthers hit the road again on Thursday, December 11 in the Rio Hondo Tournament. The "CHP" open up against Glendale at 1:00 pm. The tournament runs from Dec 11 – 13.
