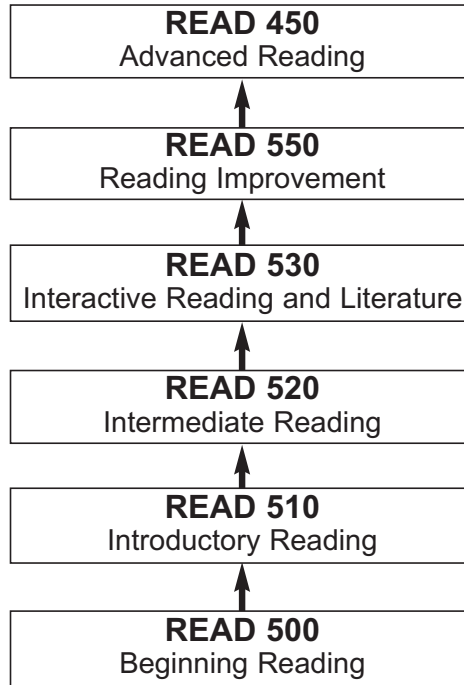


READING COURSE SEQUENCE

The ability to read and comprehend written information is an essential skill. Starting with the right class for you will ensure your success and help you become a more effective reader. For each of these courses, the corequisite reading laboratory reinforces learning objectives by providing students with additional assistance and reading practice.



READ 500 Beginning Reading

3 units

Corequisite: READ 591

Beginning reading class for students having extreme difficulty with reading, with a variety of backgrounds and learning skills. Specific reading skills: phonics, basic sight vocabulary, comprehension, and following directions.

READ 510 Introduction to Reading

3 units

Corequisite: READ 591

Beginning reading class for students with a variety of backgrounds and learning skills. Specific reading skills, such as locating the main idea, making inferences, vocabulary improvement, and understanding paragraphs.

READ 520 Intermediate Reading

3 units

Corequisite: READ 591

Introductory reading and study skills class for students with a variety of backgrounds and learning skills. Improves reading and study skills abilities. Focuses on reading comprehension, vocabulary development, and study skills techniques.

READ 530 Interactive Reading and Literature

3 units

Corequisite: READ 591

Focus on reading comprehension, literary terminology, and vocabulary development using literature as a basis.

READ 550 Reading Improvement

3 units

Corequisite: READ 591

Program of systematic training to develop literal and critical comprehension, vocabulary, and speed skills for students with average reading skills.

READ 450 Advanced Reading

3 units

Corequisite: READ 591

Program of systematic training to develop literal and critical comprehension, vocabulary, and speed skills for advanced students.
