Why should you improve your English?

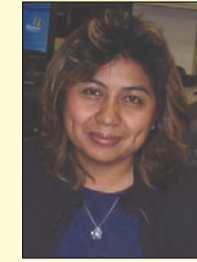

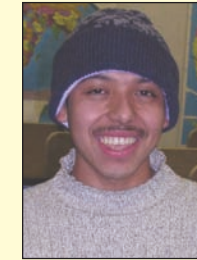

GETTING STARTED

Step 1: Submit Application

Obtain a Chaffey College Application for Admission on our website (www.chaffey.edu) or at any of the college's five locations. Complete the application online, mail it, or bring it to the Admissions Office. You will be assigned a date to register.

Step 2: Complete Assessment and Orientation

Assessment testing and orientation are provided at the Rancho campus and the off-campus sites. To schedule an appointment for assessment, call the Counseling Department (909) 941-2116.

Step 3: Register for Classes

Register on your assigned registration date online at www.chaffey.edu or call the Panther Line at (909) 466-2800. Walk-in registration is available at a later date.

Step 4: Pay your Fees

To complete your registration, pay your fees by the payment deadline over the phone, online, by fax, or in person. After you have paid for your classes, go to the Admissions Office to get your student I.D.

Step 5: Start School!

Step 6: Visit the Language Success Center

Located in SL-17 for tutoring or lab activities, bring your student I.D. and start using the center.

CENTER USE FOR NON-CREDIT

Go to the Admissions Office, complete an application, state that your status will be for non-credit lab access and then you will be directed to get a student I.D. Bring your student I.D. to the Language Success Center in SL-17 to start non-credit ESL learning.
