

## SUMMER 2017 PELL GRANT

To be eligible to receive a Summer 2017 Pell Grant, you must meet all of the following criteria:

- You must have a completed financial aid file for the 2016-2017 award year at Chaffey College.
- You must not be Ineligible or Disqualified based on the Satisfactory Academic Progress standards for Financial Aid.
- If you were determined ineligible or disqualified, you will need to submit a new appeal for the Summer 2017 to be considered for a Summer Pell Grant.
- Students who are attending Chaffey College in Summer 2017, are Pell Grant eligible and did not receive 100% of their full award during Fall 2016 and Spring 2017. If you have been awarded Pell Grant, it will be automatically accepted in the award letter.
- For the Summer 2017 term, the enrollment status for Financial Aid calculation purposes will be the same as the regular semester enrollment status.

**We will begin processing for Summer Pell Grant before the end of May. If you are a current Pell Grant recipient, our system will automatically determine your eligibility after you enroll for the summer term. If you meet all of the eligibility requirements, you will be sent an updated award notification by email. Payment will be adjusted based upon your enrollment. You will be notified via e-mail regarding eligibility of payment.**

**Important Reminder: Every student's eligibility is different. Your actual Summer Pell Grant may vary depending on your EFC, your remaining Pell Grant eligibility, your summer enrollment status and your Pell Lifetime Eligibility Used (PLEU).**

Federal Pell Grant awards will be divided in two payments each semester. The first disbursement will be issued during the first week of the semester. Disbursements will be made to eligible students based on 2016-2017 financial aid file, who have Pell awarded and are enrolled in courses. Payment is based on the number of units at the time of calculation (calculations are made approximately 5-10 days before disbursement). Although you may be registered, you must be in attendance and your classes must have already started. Late start classes must begin for units to be included in first disbursement; otherwise they will be included on subsequent disbursements. Payment will be adjusted according to enrollment status.

All satisfactory academic progress (SAP) policies and return to Title IV (R2T4)/withdrawal policies and repeatability of coursework policy still apply for the summer 17 term. Failure to make Satisfactory Academic Progress during Summer 2017, could result in a loss of eligibility for Fall 2017.

Students who are on Warning status, Appeal approved (Academic Plan) status may experience a financial aid disbursement delay in their next semester until grades are posted and SAP is evaluated for Spring 17.
