

SUMMER 2018 PELL GRANT

Pell Grant eligible students can receive up to 150% of their scheduled Pell award each year. What does this mean for you? If you received a Pell Grant in 2017-18, you may qualify for a Pell Grant in summer 2018, *even if you attended* full time in both semesters. Eligible students may receive up to three Pell Grant awards between fall, spring and summer. **Note:** One full-time semester of Pell Grant equals 50% of your scheduled Pell Grant award.

To be eligible to receive a Summer 2018 Pell Grant, you must meet all of the following criteria:

- You must have a completed financial aid file for 2017-2018 award year at Chaffey College.
- Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP). You must not be Ineligible or Disqualified based on the Satisfactory Academic Progress standards for Financial Aid.
- A student who was enrolled full-time during the fall and spring semesters must be enrolled in at least 6 units for summer. Students enrolled in less than 6 units will only be eligible for a summer Pell grant if they did not use 100% of their eligibility during the fall and spring term.

If you are a current Pell Grant recipient, and your financial aid file is complete and reviewed, you will be sent an email through your Chaffey College Panther email address. Your financial aid awards will be available under MyChaffey Portal via financial aid self service. Payment will be adjusted based upon your enrollment.

Important facts:

- Every student's eligibility is different. Your actual Summer Pell Grant may vary depending on your EFC, your remaining Pell Grant eligibility, your summer enrollment status and your Pell Lifetime Eligibility Used (PLEU).
- Your PELL Lifetime Eligibility Used (LEU) will also be increased.

Federal Pell Grant awards will be divided in two payments each semester. The first disbursement will be issued during the first week of the semester. Disbursements will be made to eligible students who have Pell awarded and are enrolled in courses. Payment is based on the number of units at the time of calculation (calculations are made approximately 5-10 days before disbursement). Although you may be registered, you must be in attendance and your classes must have already started. Late start classes must begin for units to be included in first disbursement; otherwise they will be included on subsequent disbursements. Payment will be adjusted according to enrollment status.

All satisfactory academic progress (SAP) policies and return to Title IV (R2T4)/withdrawal policies and repeatability of coursework policy still apply for the summer 18 term. Failure to make Satisfactory Academic Progress during Summer 2018, could result in a loss of eligibility for Fall 2018.

Students who are on *Warning status, Appeal approved (Academic Plan) status* may experience a financial aid disbursement delay in their next semester until grades are posted and SAP is evaluated for *Spring 18*.
