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1.3 BOARD MISSION AND STYLE

1.3.1 Purpose

The purpose of governance is that the Governing Board, on behalf of the people of the communities in the district, guarantees the accountability of the Chaffey Community College District by assuring that it (a) achieves appropriate results for appropriate persons at an appropriate cost, and (b) avoids unacceptable activities, conditions and decisions.

1.3.2 Authority

The Governing Board is subject to the provisions of the Constitution of the State of California, the California Education Code, the rules and regulations of the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges pertinent federal legislation, and its own policies and procedures.

1.3.3 Governing Style

The Governing Board deliberates with many voices but governs with one. The Board shall strive to govern with excellence with emphasis on outward vision, strategic leadership, and a future orientation. It shall encourage diversity in viewpoints and collective decisions. It shall strive for a clear distinction between Board and chief executive roles. The Governing Board shall:

- A. Cultivate a sense of group responsibility using the expertise of individual members to enhance the ability of the Board as a body.
- B. Direct, control and inspire the organization through the careful establishment of broad written policies reflecting the Board's values and perspectives.
- C. Fulfill the responsibility to be stewards of the public's interests by recognizing and considering multiple perspectives from diverse communities in affirming a common vision for the district.
