

PROCEDURE NAME: 5.2.5 Financial Aid

Reference: 20 U.S.C. Sections 1070 et seq.; 34 CFR Section 668; Education Code Section 76300; Title 5, Sections 58600 et seq.

Note: This procedure is required. It addresses the Chaffey Policy: Chapter 5: Student Services, 5.2.5 Financial Aid

Purpose: *To assist students in applying for financial aid, promote financial aid awareness, award aid in an honest, fair, and equitable manner, and administer the financial aid programs to ensure compliance with federal and state laws and regulations.*

1. Chaffey College coordinates and provides financial assistance to students. Financial aid at Chaffey College is administered in accordance with federal, state and institutional policies.
2. There are various scholarships, grants, work programs, waivers, and loans available for students who are eligible for financial assistance. These forms of financial assistance are grouped into the following categories: federal programs, state programs and private scholarships.
3. The Federal and State programs that Chaffey College participates in are as follows:
 - 3.1 California Board of Governors Fee Waiver (BOGW)
 - 3.2 Federal Pell Grant
 - 3.3 Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant Program (SEOG)
 - 3.4 Federal Work Study Program
 - 3.5 Federal Family Educational Loan Program (FFELP)
 - 3.6 California Grant B & C (CAL Grant A & CAL Grant C)
 - 3.7 Other recourses (i.e., EOPS, LEAP, CARE, Cal Works, etc.)
4. In accordance with the policy, the Financial Aid Office has procedures written in accordance to federal and state regulation regarding financial aid application procedures and deadlines, student eligibility, payment procedures, overpayment recovery, account requirements, default prevention, and satisfactory academic progress. The procedures are located in the Financial Aid Policy and Procedure Manual in the Financial Aid Office.
