

PROCEDURE NAME: 5.4.2 Associated Students Elections

Reference: Education Code Section 76061

Note: This procedure is required. It addresses the Chaffey Policy: Chapter 5: Student Services, 5.4.2 Elections

Purpose: *To facilitate annual student elections to select student officers for student government.*

1. The Office of Student Activities conducts student elections for the Associated Students Organization every spring term in April.
2. Polls are open both day and evening hours. Voting is conducted at the Rancho Cucamonga campus and off-campus centers.
3. Any student elected as an officer of the Associated Students Organization must meet the requirements stated in the Associated Students of Chaffey College ratified constitution. Unit and grade point average (GPA) requirements are strictly followed. To maintain office, the student must complete nine (9) units per term and have a cumulative GPA of 2.00.
4. The governing documents for the Associated Students Organization are the Constitution and Bylaws.
5. Offices are held for one (1) year, unless disqualification occurs. There is a term limit of three years.
6. The process for disqualification is outlined in the Constitution and Bylaws of the Associated Students Organization, which is available in the office of Student Activities.
