## **Terms and Conditions of Participation**

I, the undersigned, understand that participating in this tour involves risks and dangers, including but not limited to the hazards of traveling, illness, acts of war and/or terrorism, or accidents in a foreign country. Furthermore, I agree to follow all safety guidelines as established by Chesley Art Enterprises, Inc. and the tour guide/instructor and will refrain from any behavior that might jeopardize the safety of myself, or others, on the tour. It is understood that participants must obey the laws of the countries that are visited. I hereby agree to be responsible for my own welfare. I accept any and all risks of illness, injury, unanticipated delay, accident, unexpected events, acts of war and/or terrorism, weather, emotional trauma, or death and attest to such by signing below.

I understand Chesley Art Enterprises, Inc., the guide/instructor or the college reserves the right to require any participant to withdraw from the program at any time if it is determined that a participant's conduct is detrimental to or incompatible with the interest, harmony, comfort, safety or welfare to the program or an individual. Behavior for dismissal would include, but is not limited to, abuse of alcohol, the use of drugs not prescribed by a medical doctor, or disruptive or uncooperative behavior. Participants who are dismissed from the program or leave early will not receive class credit or a refund of any kind. All additional costs incurred as a result of being dismissed or leaving early are the responsibility of the participant including alternate accommodations and transportation home.

I understand that I am responsible for carrying and watching my own luggage. Chesley Art Enterprises, Inc. does not provide porters and any use of such is at my own expense. Further, it is understood that train and museum admissions are paid by the Tour provider based on the printed itinerary. If, I do not wish to participate in that days events, there will be no refund, and if I wish to see that museum/church/event at a later time, I understand that I will be responsible for the costs. Also, if I wish to leave the tour, at any time or to travel on my own, I will be responsible for my decision and for all costs incurred. (This includes optional side trips, with the tour guide.) I further understand that smoking is not allowed on the airplane or in any accommodations where non-smokers may be staying. I understand that efforts will be made to place smokers in the same room/s, but this may not be possible. I understand that I may be required to pay a single room supplement, if I smoke in a non-smoking room.

I understand that the program guide/instructor may make changes to the itinerary at any time to best meet the needs and requirements of the group. If such changes are made, Chesley Art Enterprises, Inc., the guide/instructor or the college is not responsible for any costs incurred as a result of the change and no refunds will be will be issued.

To the best of my knowledge, I am in good health and will have no need of special assistance during the tour. I certify that I have enough medication, if required, for the duration of the tour and that I have a copy of my prescription for customs/legal needs. You will be advised of adjusted prices if currency exchange rates, airfare conditions, or land price rates are revised. Program fee does not include meals, passport and visa fees, personal expenses, class/college fees, required textbook(s), taxi fares.

**Payments:** I agree to the payment schedule on this application. I understand that I am responsible to make payments by the required due dates listed. I understand that continued missed payments or a seriously delinquent account may result in forfeiture of my participation in the tour with no refund of any kind. I understand there is a \$15.00 late fee for payments received 14 days or more after the due date and that there is a \$29.00 fee for any returned check.

**Cancellation:** Any cancellation request must be in writing by mail (not email) and the effective date of the request will be on the day that Chesley Art Enterprises, Inc. receives the request. **It is strongly recommended that participants purchase a travel insurance plan which includes cancellation insurance.** (See specific insurance policy for details of policy benefits and restrictions. **Refund:** Any request for refund must be in writing by mail (not email) and the effective date of the request will be on the day that Chesley Art Enterprises, Inc. receives the request. For a refund request received June 10, 2008 or later, or a tour participant who is a no-show for any reason, the participant will not receive a refund of any kind. See Table Below:
