Please join us for a unique artist's talk/performance/fundraiser with LA-based artist Edith Abeyta. Abeyta will talk about her current project, ***Pie-Raiser: baking pies for art***, a continuation of her participatory project, ***Apple Pie Saturday's***. In 2004 she visited the home's of friends and strangers every Saturday for a year to bake a homemade apple pie and interview participants throughout CA and England. Abeyta conducted exhaustive documentation of her visits and the interactions that occurred in audio & photographic form. Later, Abeyta created a number of installations investigating the political and social ramifications of her performances and interviews. With ***Pie-Raiser***, Edith will make a pie while discussing her current project. Afterwards, she will sell the homemade apple pie's to raise funds for her continued artistic practice. All pie's will be sold at a self-determined price and supplies are limited. Edith will be on-site to sell her pie's until they're sold out.

Abeyta has exhibited in group and solo exhibitions throughout California and across the United States, the Netherlands and most recently at the Burapha Art Museum and University in Chonburi, Thailand.
