Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for participation in the CEP the following is required:

- Complete the Chaffey College ADN program application. Indicate on the application the Concurrent Enrollment ADN/BSN option.
- Complete all Chaffey College and CSUSB prerequisite and lower division GE requirements:
 - Student's prior coursework will be evaluated for Cal-GETC or CSU general education transfer certification requirements before acceptance
 - Meet the overall cumulative GPA of 2.75 in all Chaffey College nursing preadmission required courses
 - Maintain a 2.0 GPA in all coursework while enrolled in the CEP program
 - Attend mandatory CEP Information Session

Application Steps

1. Attend a Chaffey College ADN Information Session
2. Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended to Chaffey's Admissions & Records office
3. Be accepted to the Chaffey College ADN program
4. Gain acceptance into CSUSB, Concurrent Enrollment Program
5. Complete CSUSB financial aid requirements (FAFSA required annually)
6. Attend mandatory orientation for CSUSB'S Concurrent Enrollment Program once accepted through Chaffey College.

Typical Timeline

- During Years 1 and 2 of the Chaffey ADN program, students complete one BSN course per semester with CSUSB
- Graduate from the ADN program and pass the NCLEX-RN
- Submit official Chaffey College transcript with ADN degree posted to earn an additional 16 units
- Complete remaining BSN coursework (typically 2 additional terms)
- Graduate with a BSN from CSUSB

Most students complete the BSN within one year after ADN graduation.

Financial Aid:

- Financial aid is processed through CSUSB for concurrent enrolled students
- FAFSA must be completed annually
- Students may be responsible for Chaffey College fees before CSUSB aid disburses
