Program Overview

Loma Linda University (LLU) partners with Chaffey College to offer a flexible online BSN program that allows ADN students to begin BSN coursework while completing their Associate Degree in Nursing.

The program is designed to support balance, with LLU BSN courses scheduled primarily in the summer so they do not interfere with ADN semesters. Coursework is fully online and asynchronous, allowing students to progress at their own pace.

LLU's curriculum is grounded in its mission of whole-person care – addressing not only the physical aspects of nursing but also the emotional and spiritual needs of patients.

Why Choose LLU?

Top Benefits:

- 100% online
- Asynchronous
- No on-campus attendance
- No clinical requirements for BSN courses
- Full-time: finish in 4 quarters, part time up to 9 quarters
- Mission trip opportunities: Domestic and international (scholarship available for first trip)
- To maintain a fully online program, this program does not offer a PHN certificate.

Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for LLU's Concurrent Enrollment Program, students must:

- Be accepted to the Chaffey College ADN program
- Meet LLU admission standards:
 - Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 in all college coursework
 - Prerequisites for LLU do not need to be finished before starting, but must be completed before BSN graduation
- Maintain good academic standing at both institutions

Application Steps

- Attend an LLU ADN-BSN Information Session
- Submit an application with personal statement
- Submit two letters of recommendation—optional
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended
- Proof of completion of high school or equivalent
- All qualified applicants will participate in an interview

Typical Timeline

- During Years 1 and 2 of the Chaffey ADN program, students will complete LLU BSN courses based on their personalized plan
- Graduate from the ADN program and pass the NCLEX-RN exam
- Complete remaining BSN coursework at LLU and graduate with a BSN from LLU

Tuition, Costs & Financial Aid

LLU offers a partner-rate tuition discount for Chaffey students.

Cost Overview

- Approximately \$424 per unit
- 46 quarter total BSN units
- Estimated total program cost: \$19,504 plus textbooks and applicable fees
