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Program Overview

Azusa Pacific University (APU) offers a flexible, fully online BSN program designed for ADN students who want to start their BSN early.

Through the Integrative Enrollment Pathway (IEP), students can take BSN courses while completing the ADN program at Chaffey College.

This allows you to complete the BSN more quickly and spread out the workload in a manageable way.

Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for APU's Integrative Enrollment Pathway (IEP), students must:

- Be accepted to the Chaffey College ADN program
- Meet APU admission standards:
 - Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50
 - Minimum 2.00 GPA in all nursing prerequisites
- Maintain good academic standing at both institutions

Application Steps

1. Attend an APU ADN-BSN Information Session
2. Submit the online APU nursing application
3. Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended
4. Gain acceptance into IEP program
5. Complete APU financial aid requirements (FAFSA required annually)
6. Activate your APU student portal
7. Meet with an APU academic advisor to develop a progression plan
8. Register for your first BSN course

Typical Timeline

- During Years 1 and 2 of the Chaffey ADN program, students complete selected APU BSN courses
- Graduate from the ADN program and pass the NCLEX-RN
- APU verifies RN licensure and 10 non-transferable units are posted to the APU transcript at no charge
- Complete remaining BSN coursework (typically 1–2 additional terms)
- Graduate with a BSN from APU

Most students complete the BSN within 6–12 months after ADN graduation.

Tuition, Costs & Financial Aid

APU offers a partner-rate tuition discount for Chaffey students.

Cost Overview:

- Approximately \$414 per unit
- 40 total BSN units
- Estimated total program cost: \$16,560 plus textbooks and applicable fees
- 10 units awarded after NCLEX-RN confirmation

Financial Aid

- Financial aid is processed through APU for dual-enrolled students
- FAFSA must be completed annually
- Students may be responsible for Chaffey College fees before APU aid disburses
