Apply February 1-28 2022 for the RT program starting Fall 2022

BIOL 20 Human Anatomy, BIOL 22 Human Physiology, Chemistry 9 or 10 or higher or Physics 5 must be completed within 5 years of the application period; end of summer 2016 for February 2022 applications.

All applicable courses must be completed by the end of the **Fall Semester 2021**. All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. ("C-"is not accepted.) The minimum degree applicable GPA is 2.8.

Students must pass ATI TEAS 6 with 62% or better within 2 attempts to be eligible to apply. The first passing score will be used in ranking. Applicant must provide TEAS results by going to the www.atitesting.com online store. There is a fee for this service. Please refer to the Information Packet on the website.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO FOLLOW ALL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS on the website.

- The RadTec application must be current. See websites for instructions. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. The Radiologic Technology Evaluation form sent to you from the Counseling Dept. must be included with your RadTec application.
- Pass the ATI TEAS 6 with a score of 62% or better within two attempts. The first passing score will be used for eligibility to apply to the program. **TEAS must be taken after March 1st, 2021.** Student must request that TEAS scores are sent from ATI directly to Chaffey College Allied Health and pay the associated fee for this service. **Scores must be received by the RadTec Program no later than Feb 28th, 2022 at 11:59 p.m.** www.atitesting.com
- The **point system** on the reverse side is provided to aid students in planning their classes prior to applying to the RadTec Program and is **subject to change by the department without notification.**

Only regionally accredited coursework will be accepted from an institution in the United States. Foreign coursework will not be considered.

Applications will be ranked according to points earned for coursework completed through the Fall term preceding the application period, then by the first passing TEAS score. Ties in points are broken on the basis of degree applicable GPA. **The minimum degree applicable GPA is 2.8.**

ADDITIONAL POINTS:

- Consideration for one additional point may be awarded for **paid prior acute care hospital** experience with sufficient verification. The point for work experience is not guaranteed until verified by the coordinators. See website: **1000 hours of direct patient care** experience must be completed within the last 5 years. Direct patient care is the care of a patient providing personal “hands-on” contact with patients in an **acute care hospital**. The acute care hospital must have an emergency room, ICU and surgical departments.
- Consideration for additional one point will be given to applicants with a current California Limited Permit in Radiologic Technology. A copy of the current permit(s) must be submitted with application. The point for work experience is not guaranteed until verified by the coordinators.
- Consideration for one additional point will be given to veterans who have been honorably discharged and meet the RT program admissions criteria. Military service documentation must be submitted with the application. Acceptable documentation includes a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214C) or a Proof of Service Letter from the Department of Veterans Affairs.
- Students will have 1 attempt to apply for additional points. Incomplete submissions will not be considered. Refer to the RT Information Packet for instructions.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The top 50 applicants will be **required** to attend an RadTec Program orientation.

The top 28 and 22 alternate applicants will be required to obtain a certificate of successfully passing a background check from an approved vendor(s). Refer to the RT website for details and for the most current information.
