

# ELEMENTARY TEACHER EDUCATION FOR TRANSFER (AA-T)

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:**

The Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer prepares students for seamless transfer to California State Universities to major in either a General Track Liberal Studies Program, or an Integrated Liberal Studies/Multiple Subject Teaching Credential Program.

The program is suited to the needs of students who will complete their education at Chaffey College with an AA degree, as well as those students who will complete their Chaffey AA degree and transfer to a four year institution to complete their bachelor's degree. Successful completion of the Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer guarantees the student acceptance to a California State University (but does not guarantee acceptance to a particular campus or major) to pursue a baccalaureate degree, in preparation to pursue a career in the field of Elementary Teacher Education.
