

# ENGLISH FOR TRANSFER (AA-T)

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Associate in Arts in English for Transfer degree gives students an appreciation of literature and increased skills in written communication. The Associate for Transfer in English degree will provide seamless transfer opportunities to California State Universities for those students desiring to transfer to CSU system. This degree is flexible enough to meet transfer requirements at four year institutions. Through the study of language and literature, students are better able to communicate, to persuade, and to understand human nature. More specifically, superior ability to understand and to use English is necessary for success in most careers, particularly those in education, writing, business, journalism, and law. The program is suited to the needs of students who will complete their education at Chaffey College with an A.A. degree, as well as those students who will complete their Chaffey A.A. degree and transfer to a four year institution to complete their bachelor's degree. Successful completion of the transfer degree in English guarantees the student acceptance to a California State University (but does not guarantee acceptance to a particular campus or major) to pursue a baccalaureate degree.
