What is Dual Enrollment

The Dual Enrollment Program is a program that allows high school students to enroll in college courses, taught by college faculty. Upon successful completion of a course, students earn units toward a college certificate and/or degree. Participation in the program allows students to develop the skillset needed to navigate the higher education system and get ahead. The program is tuition-free and available to all California students who are approved by their high school counselor or administrator to participate.

4. RESEARCH shows that students who participate in Dual Enrollment programs are more likely to graduate from high school and persist in college!



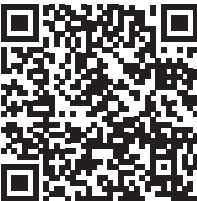
ELIGIBILITY

- Incoming 9th grade - 12th grade
- No GPA Requirement
- No SSN Requirement
- Dual Enrollment students (also known as "Special Part-time Admits") may enroll in up to 11 units for Fall, Spring and Summer.

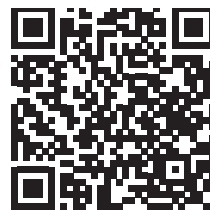

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- Be sure to enter your name and date of birth correctly. (Only enter two last names or hyphenated names if you use both names on ALL documents).
- Applicants will receive two emails: a general welcome email and a Dual Enrollment Program email.
- Enter a phone number where you can be contacted
- Select high school from dropdown, **DO NOT** choose "Other" and type name
- **SSN numbers are not needed on the application**
- If you are a **graduating 8th grader** (incoming 9th grader), please list the high school you **WILL BE** attending in fall. Do not leave high school blank.
- Use a personal email address. (Not a school or parent's email address)
- Under "Educational Status" select **"Attending high school and college at the same time"**

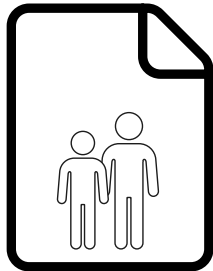

Students may participate in the dual enrollment program by submitting a High School Partnership or HSPFLEX enrollment form. HSP reserves seats in college courses for students who attend the following districts (and select Charter Schools): Chaffey Joint Union HS District, Chino Valley Unified School District, Fontana Unified School District, and Upland Unified School District

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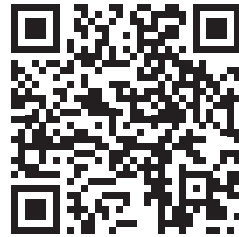
